

The Desires of the Divine Heart of God The Father

God the Father has repeatedly requested that He be paid the homage due to Him, through veneration and worship of His Divine Heart. The Eternal Father has emphasized consistently that He deeply desires to be known, loved, adored, praised, worshipped, and glorified by everyone, so that the era of His Reign may finally come fully on earth. The desires of the Father's Heart are:

1. That everyone returns back to live in His Divine Will through Consecration to His Divine Heart and a voluntary union of wills. Like that cessation of conflict will ensue, the Father's peace, love, joy, and happiness will be granted, and the era of His reign of peace will come fully on earth.
2. That cenacles be held weekly in honor of His Divine Heart by all individuals, families, communities, and societies.
3. That these cenacles be held in order for participants to obtain and renew the protective Seal of God the Father for our current and forthcoming times, and to obtain all the graces needed in order to live habitually in the Father's Divine Will.
4. That veneration and worship be given by everyone to God the Father's Divine Heart, in atonement for all the sins committed against Him, especially sins of blasphemy. Veneration and worship are effectively carried out through prayer from the heart in front of the picture of the icon of the Divine Heart of God the Father as shown overleaf.
5. That the cenacles be held to console the Father's Divine Heart, calming His Wrath and increasing His Mercy, thus lessening the consequences and shortening the time of the upcoming Chastisement.

The Seal of God The Father

The Seal of God the Father (Rv 3:10-12) serves as one of the entryways into the Divine Heart and Will of the Father, and the New Jerusalem (Rv 3,21,22), the descent of which from Heaven has commenced. The Scriptural lineage of the Seal of the Father dates back to the Seal of Yahweh, conferred through the anointing of Aaron by Moses, after the exodus of the Israelites from Egypt.

The Seal of the Father and the Mark of the Beast

The Seal of God the Father both supercedes and annuls the name, number, and mark of the beast of the Book of Revelation (Rv 13, 14). If one has been marked through deliberate systemic sin but desires to return to live in God's favor, becoming consecrated to the Divine Heart of the Father and obtaining His Seal, after a good Confession and firm purpose of amendment, both annuls the mark and seals the soul. The Father's Seal also confers much-needed spiritual immunity on a soul through grace, in relation to the forthcoming attacks by Satan and his agents during the expected Chastisement. Therefore the Seal of God the Father is both spiritual remedy and protection for souls during the present and upcoming times.

Outcome of Consecration and Obtaining the Father's Seal

On becoming sealed by God the Father through voluntary consecration to Him, the person's soul then becomes directly the full property of the Father. However if one decides not to remain in a state of sanctifying grace by committing mortal sin, the Seal is violated and the Sacrament of Reconciliation (i.e., Confession) needs to be attended prior to renewing it. The Seal of the Father is renewed through daily participation in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and worthy reception of the Eucharist. The Seal is also renewable through participation in weekly cenacles to the Divine Heart of the Father, which result on the provision of all graces needed to live in the Father's Divine Will.

Cenacles to the Divine Heart of God The Father

Below is the formal prayer format for cenacles of worship to be held to the Divine Heart of God the Father. The cenacles are to be held both in honor of, and to fulfill, the desires of the Father's Heart. Among the promises given by God the Father to regular participants in these cenacles is that of receiving all the graces needed in order for one to live habitually in the Father's Divine Will.

Formal Prayer Format for Cenacles

1. Prayer to the Holy Spirit¹
2. Rosary of Mary, the Mother of God (five decades)
3. Rosary of the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ²
4. Prayer to Saint Michael³
5. The Consecration Prayer to the Divine Heart of God the Father.
6. Prayer to the Holy Spirit¹

¹Come Holy spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your Love. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. Let us pray. O God, Who did instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the same Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolation, through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

The prayer to the Holy Spirit is said twice at the Father's specific request, to plead with the Spirit to descend increasingly into people's hearts.
